## **Tenn. State Tigers - Southern Jaguars**

### **Play Rubber-Game in Latest Series**

In 2007, Tennessee State and Southern renewed their long-standing rivalry playing in Baton Rouge, LA after a sixteen year hiatus. The Jaguars utilized a second half surge to drop the Tigers 41-34. Last season, Tennessee State returned the favor dispatching the Jaguars 34-32 in the John Merritt Classic.

Tonight's game is the rubber match of this renewal of the rivalry which began in 1945, with TSU holding a 26-11-2 edge in the overall series match-up.

Both teams show a 1-1 worksheet on the season and come off victories in their last game. Tennessee State held on to defeat Jackson State 14-7 at the Southern Heritage Classic in Memphis and Southern shut out Central State (O) by a score of 68-0 at home in Baton Rouge.

Last week, red-shirt sophomore QB Calvin McNairl led the Tigers offense with 101 rushing yards and 1 touchdown. Returning to action for the first time in two year he passed for only 43 yards, but earned MVP honors at the Southern Heritage Classic for engineering the TSU victory.

Southern's offense is led by QB, Bryant Lee, a All-SWAC Preseason selection. is averaging 237 passing yards per game after accounting for 257 yards of total offense and four touchdowns in the Jaguars win last week. His favorite target, Juamorris Stewart has caught 16 passes for 260 yards (130.0 ypg) and 2 touchdowns

## This Week's Game

After picking up their first win of the season at the Southern Heritage Classic (SHC), the Tennessee State University football team will head to Baton Rouge, La. to face Southern University. The match-up is scheduled for September 19th with a 6 p.m. kick-off at A.W. Mumford Stadium.

The game marks the 43rd meeting with TSU holding the all-time series record, 22-18-2. Last year the Tigers rallied back from an 11-0 halftime deficit to edge the Jaguars, 34-32 in the 10th Annual John Merritt Classic in Nashville. In 2007, TSU played in A.W. Mumford Stadium losing 41-34 after holding an eight-point lead at the half.

The Tigers (1-1) were able to bounce back after a season opening loss and are fresh off a 14-7 victory over Jackson State. The Tiger attack received an offensive spark from classic MVP quarterback Calvin McNairl.

McNairl, in his first appearance of the season, gave the Tigers their first offensive score of the season scoring a six-yard touchdown. He finished with 14 carries for 101 yards (7.2 avg) with a 54-yard scamper to set up a TSU score in the fourth quarter. He also completed 4 of 11 passes for 43 yards.

On the attack, TSU is mustering 225.5 yards of total offense scoring 14 total points in their first two outings. At the running back position, Dante' Thomas gives TSU the most productivity averaging 5.1 yards per carry.

TSU has leaned heavily on their defense posting nine points, four sacks, three interceptions while holding teams to 124 yards on the ground. The Tiger defenders are led by Eugene

Clifford, Anthony Levine, and John Jones, Jr.

Jones leads the Tigers in tackles with 12 on the season recording a safety versus Jackson State. Clifford follows with nine tackles and a fumble recovery for a score. Levine currently has seven tackles with a 51-yard interception return that set up a TSU score last week.

The Jaguars (1-1) enter this week's contest having bolted past Central State 68-0. Offensively, Southern is averaging 43.5 points per game with more than 400 yards of total offense. SU's offense is led by 2009 SWAC Preseason selection quarterback Bryant Lee, wide receiver Juamorris Stewart, and offensive lineman Raymond Chinyoung. Receiving SWAC second team pre-season honors were Dexter James (DL), Allan Baugh (LB), Lee Almanza (DL), and Josh Duran (P/K).

Lee currently averages 237 passing yards per game after accounting for 257 yards of total offense and four touchdowns in the Jaguars win last week. Stewart has only two receptions with two TDs on the year but has capitalized on the yards-after-catch averaging 130 receiving yards per game. Lee and Stewart were both named to the 2008 All SWAC First Team.

Defensively, defensive back Timothy Berry was named SWAC Newcomer of the Week following the Jaguars' season opening 42-19 loss Louisiana. Berry currently has eight tackles on the season with linebacker Marcus Clark leading the team with nine. The Jaguars at the start of the season are holding teams to 288 total yards per game tallying three sacks, three forced fumbles and four interceptions on the year.

#### **The Tigers:**

- Are fielding their 94th varsity football team this season.
- Playing in the Ohio Valley Conference for the 22nd season.
- Have won 14 Black College National Championships.
- Play their home games in LP Field, home of the NFL Tennessee Titans. The capacity of 67,800 makes it the largest home facility used by an NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) team.
- TSU has had seven players picked in the first round of the NFL Draft including a #1 overall pick in 1974 with Ed "Too Tall" Jones being picked by the Dallas Cowboys. The latest, Dominique Rodgers-Cromartie was picked #16 overall by the Arizona Cardinals.
- There are currently four TSU players on NFL rosters at the beginning of the 2009 season; DB-Dominique Rodgers-Cromartie (Arizona Cardinals), RB-Javarris Williams (Kansas City Chiefs - PS), OL-Cecil Newton (Jacksonville Jaguars - PS) and DL-Lamar Divens (Baltimore Ravens - IR).

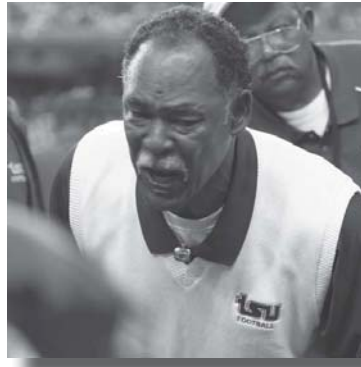
### **Record Return**

Eugene Clifford's 78 yard fumble return for a TD against Alabama A&M (09/05/09) is the longest in modern TSU football history. The previous record was 73 yards, set by Shaun Richardson against Austin Peay (09/15/07).

## **Head Coach - James Webster, Jr.**

• Webster made an immediate impact on the Tigers program since being named head coach in Jan. 2005. After a 2-9 year and 1-6 mark (eighth place) in the OVC in his first season, the Tigers were back above .500 in year No. 2 (6-5) and won four more Conference games, as they finished 5-2 and were third in the OVC. It marked just the third winning season in the last seven years and equaled the most Conference wins since 2003. Tennessee State repeated that third place OVC finish in 2007, finishing 4-3 in OVC play.

• With over 31 years of coaching experience, Webster has had many impressive stops on his resume. He was an assistant at his alma mater - North Carolina - to begin his career (1973) and later coached at Florida (1974), Kansas (1975-78), Colorado (1979-81), Northwestern (1982-84), Wake Forest (1988-93), Dartmouth (1993-95) and East Carolina (1995-00) before returning to UNC in 2001 (and staying until 2004). He has also had experience working with the Pittsburgh Steelers and St. Louis Rams in the NFL.

• Webster has coached teams in the 1979 Sugar Bowl, 1976 Sun Bowl, 1988 Independence Bowl, 1998 Liberty Bowl, 1999 Mobile Bowl, 2001 Peach Bowl and 2004 Continental Tire Bowl.

• As a coach at North Carolina, Webster coached All-American Julius Peppers, the 2001 Lombardi and Bednarik award winner. Peppers was drafted No. 2 overall (by Carolina) in the 2002 NFL Draft. UNC ranked 15th nationally in total defense in 2001.

• As a player at North Carolina (1968-72), Webster started at linebacker for three consecutive seasons. He was named the Defensive MVP of the 1971 Gator Bowl.
